RE: Movement of pharmacy employees between their residence and place of work


This letter has been issued by the, The Royal Pharmaceutical Society (RPS), and the General Pharmaceutical Council (GPhC) in support of the legitimate movement of pharmacy employees between their home and place of work.

Pharmacists, Pharmacy Technicians and their support staff are categorised as key NHS workers in the response to the COVID19 pandemic. Pharmacy staff are working extremely hard on the frontline to maintain the supply of medicines and healthcare advice to the public. It is essential that they are able to travel freely between their place of residence and place of work for this to continue.

Many pharmacy teams' members will not have an NHS ID badge as they are employed by organisations contracted to the NHS, as is the case with almost all of the community pharmacies throughout Great Britain.

Please accept this letter, stamped by the pharmacy employer, as validation of this individual's status as a key NHS worker for the delivery of frontline NHS services.
