THEME	DESCRIPTOR
5.1 Role Model	Understands and demonstrates the characteristics of a role model to members in the team and/or service.
5.2 Mentorship	Demonstrates ability to effectively mentor others within the team and/or service.
5.3 Conducting Education and Training	Demonstrates ability to assess the performance and learning needs of others. Demonstrates ability to plan a series of effective learning experiences for others.
5.4 Professional Development	Facilitates the professional development of others.
5.5 Links Practice and Education	Participates in education and training in an external environment.
5.6 Educational Policy	Demonstrates an understanding of current educational policies relevant to working areas of practice.
