

Pharmacy: Delivering a Healthier Wales Delivery Board

The third meeting of the *Pharmacy: Delivering a Healthier Wales* Delivery Board took place on 15th October. Chaired by Darren Hughes, Director of the Welsh NHS Confederation, the Board is playing a key role in shaping the progress of the Pharmacy Vision.

At this latest meeting the Board's discussions centred on:

Measures and sub-group feedback

- Following the Board's previous meeting (10 October) a sub-group was established to consider what measures and key enablers were required to achieve the 2022 goals. The short life working group met on the 1st and 7th of October to discuss the existing 2022 goals in each of the four themes:
 - Enhancing Patient Experience
 - Developing the Pharmacy Workforce
 - Seamless Pharmaceutical Care
 - Innovation and Technology

The sub-group members were mindful that the original intention of the 2022 goals was to enable progression towards the ten-year ambition in the vision.

- Marc Donovan, Community Pharmacy Wales Board Member, fed back to the Board the sub-group's recommendations, providing a set of measures against each of the 2022 goals. The Board discussed how these may be achieved and what progress had already been made. It was agreed having a clear set of measures would enable the Board to monitor progress going forward.
- Ownership of each of the 2022 goals and their measures will be agreed by the Board. An initial first draft of where ownership may best sit will be shared with the Board in due course and discussed at the next meeting if required.
- The next meeting of the *Pharmacy: Delivering a Healthier Wales* Delivery Board will take place on Thursday 19 November.
